During the national Odyssee-Mure seminar, participants had the opportunity to:

- Learn about the latest developments and methodological contributions of the project (especially the decomposition analysis and the energy efficiency scoreboard);
- View the latest draft country profile, which was prepared by the Odyssee-Mure national team a few days before the seminar, and discuss about the quality of the data and the interpretation of the results shown in that profile;
- Discuss the methodology and the findings about the investment needs to achieve the energy efficiency goals of Cyprus up to 2030;
- Discuss about how to properly target the population suffering from (or at risk of) energy
 poverty: the criteria to identify energy-vulnerable households, the measures that can be
 implemented in light of the experience gathered in Europe so far, and the ways to ensure
 the uptake of energy efficiency measures by the vulnerable population, i.e. behaviourallyinformed actions that can help increase the success of any funding schemes that target
 energy poverty.
